Cultivate Values for Leaders of Tomorrow, Create Space to Foster Whole-person Development

All individuals are the same, and there is no difference among individuals. Based on the principle of providing whole-person development, through the 'MVP Scheme' by offering learning experiences in Music, Visual Arts and Physical Education to our students, students are able to choose various activities according to their interests, explore and pursue excellence. After undergoing three years of epidemic, our staff has been working eagerly awaiting the return of our students for whole-day face-to-face classes with the adoption of the EDB's theme 'Cultivate Values for Leaders of Tomorrow, Create Space to Foster Whole-person Development'. We expect students to utilize school hours and create more space for conducting diversified learning.

In our new whole day timetable, various afternoon learning sessions have been set up.

- 1. Through 'Daily Gratitude', students can conclude a day of learning by performing relaxation and tranquillity exercise for reflection.
- 2. The new 'Happy Hour' is arranged for students to participate in learning experiences outside classrooms.
- 3. Weekly reading session is also incorporated into the timetable, such that teachers and students can enjoy reading together, cultivate reading interest and habits.

The whole-day lesson timetable is planned based on the half-day version, envisaging our students to employ their learning time well and independently.

Meanwhile, our school has also successfully applied for a number of funding in this academic year, including Quality Education Fund, Jockey Club Joy of E-Reading Scheme and Knowing More About IT Programme, providing students with interactive whiteboard, equipment for digital Chinese calligraphy, virtual reality sets, 3D printing and IT equipment for teaching and learning. Besides the implementation of BYOD programme for P.3-P.6 students, the newly set up 'Digital Reading Platform' and

e-library offer online platforms for all students to read anytime and anywhere.
